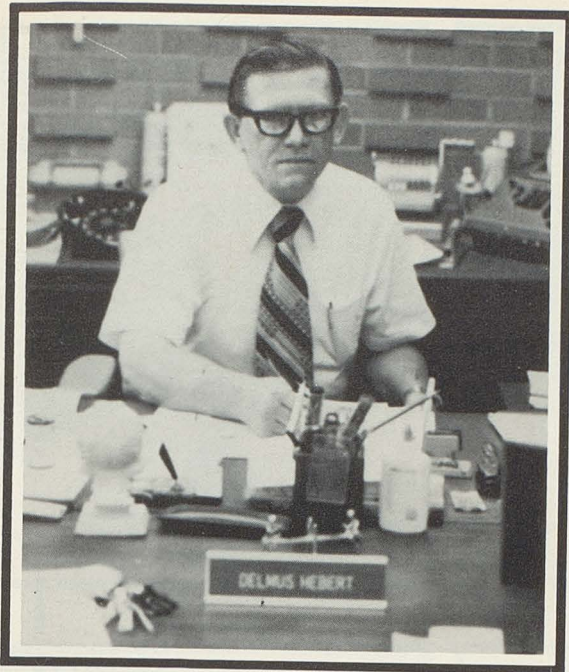




## Principal's Message
