This is the comfort of friends, that though they may be said to die, yet their friendship and society are, in the best sense, ever present because immortal.

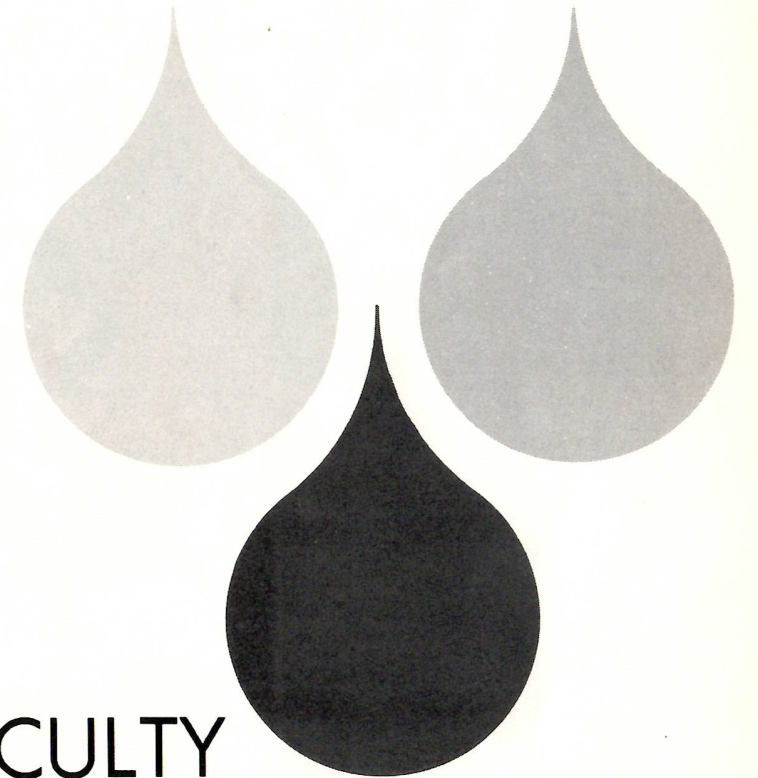

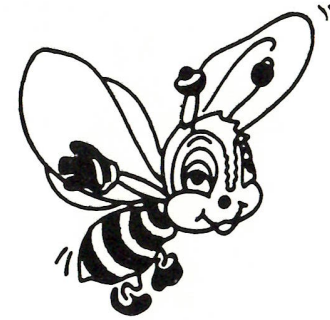
