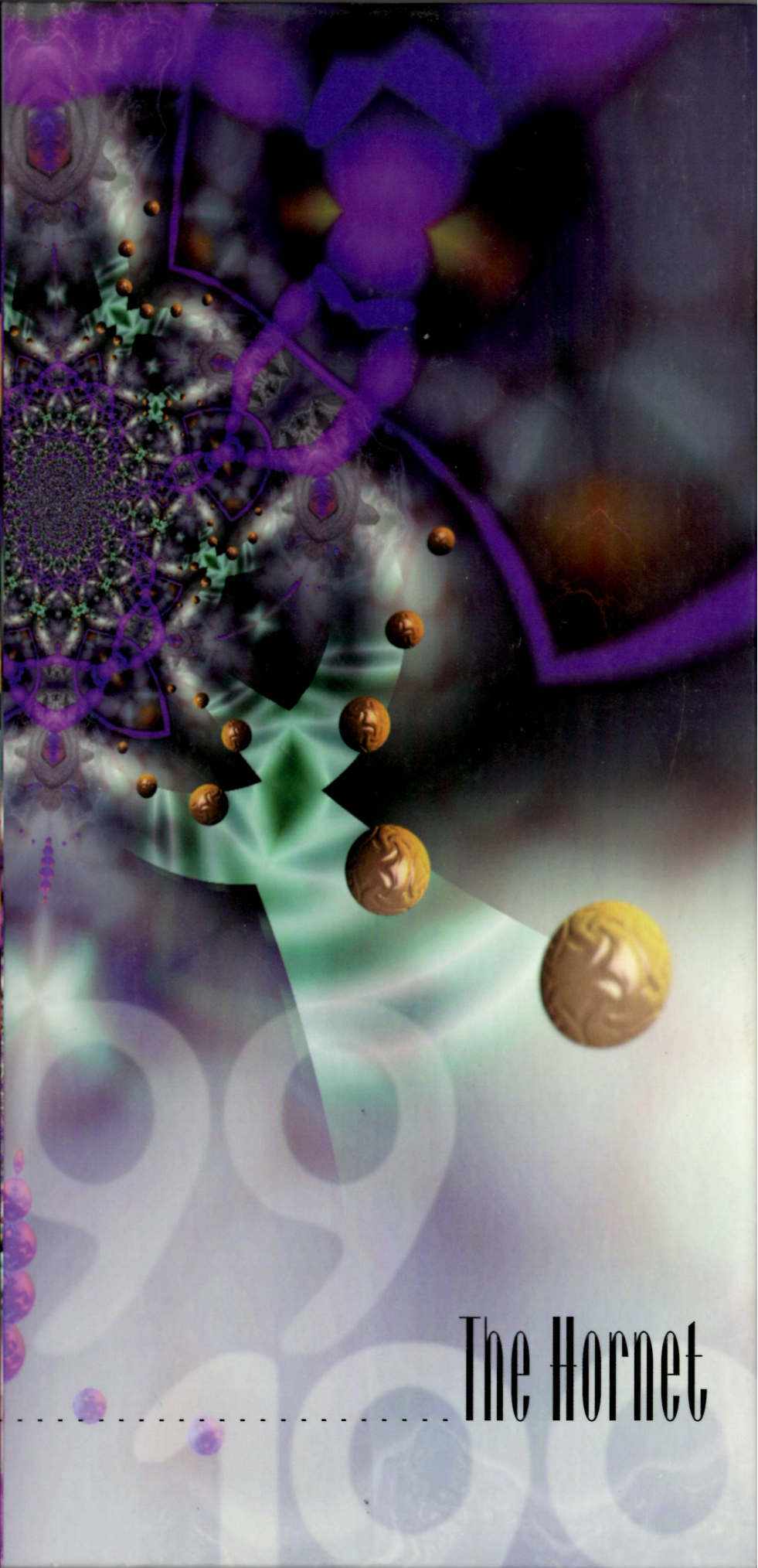

Being in the halls is not always all fun and games.

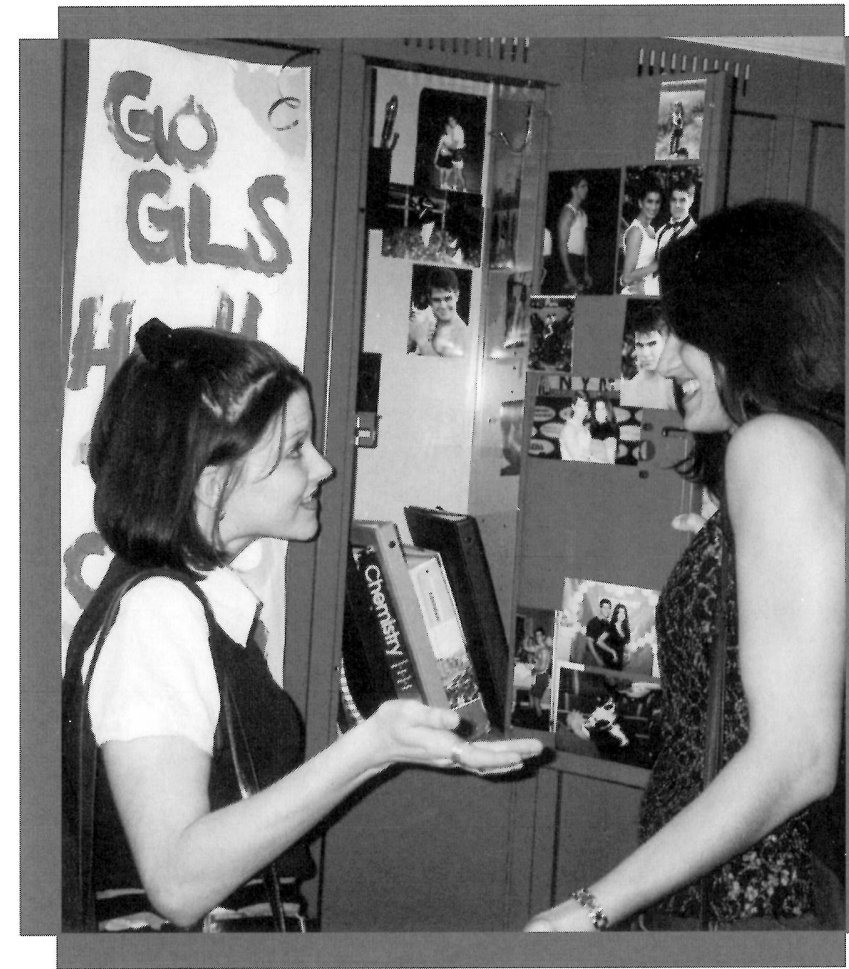
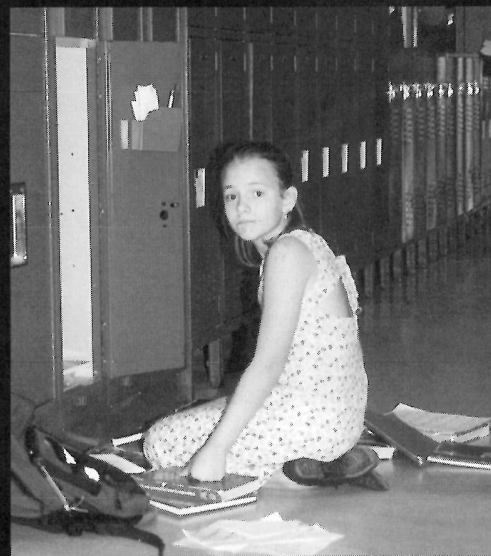

BUSTED! In the hall Ms. Fletcher nabbed yet another sophomore to give him the "hug of the day."

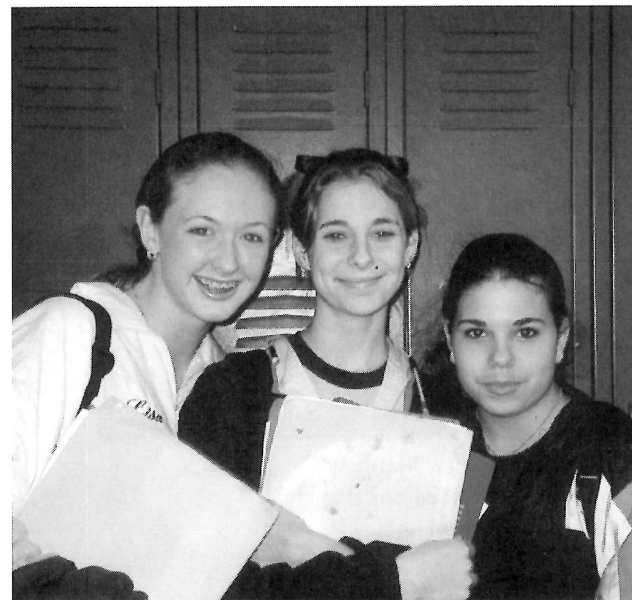
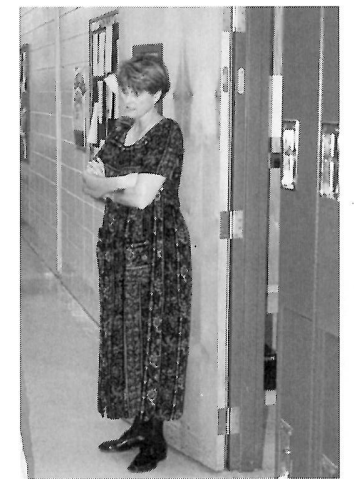

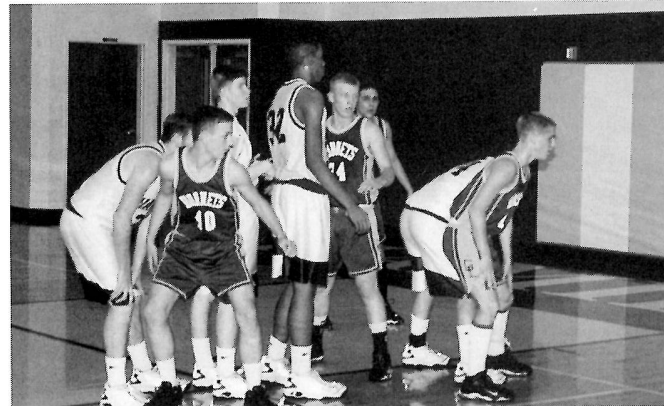
The team showed their strength by starting off the season 4-0 and placing first in the Grand Lake Tournament. During the entire sea-

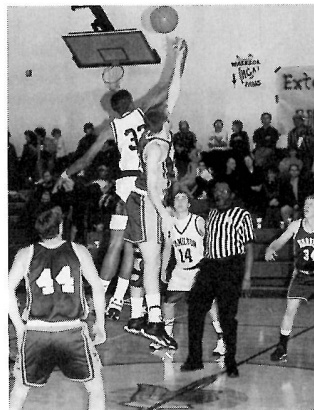

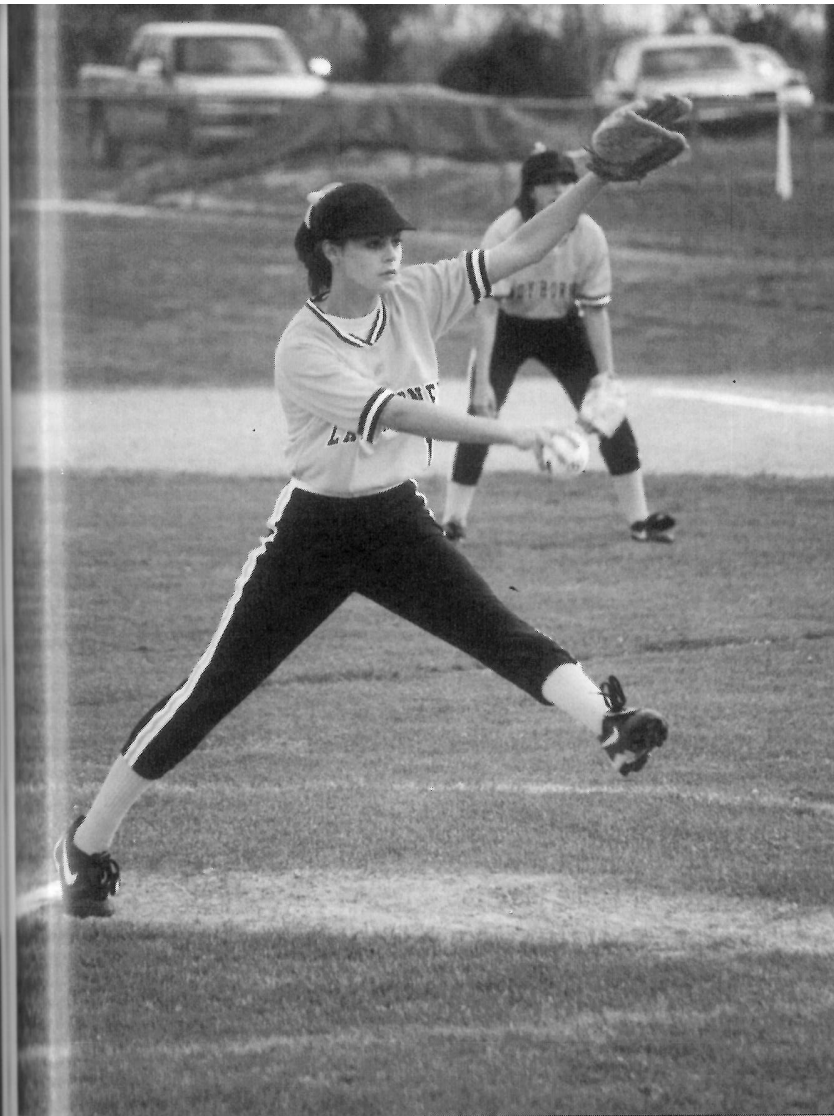
What a Game!

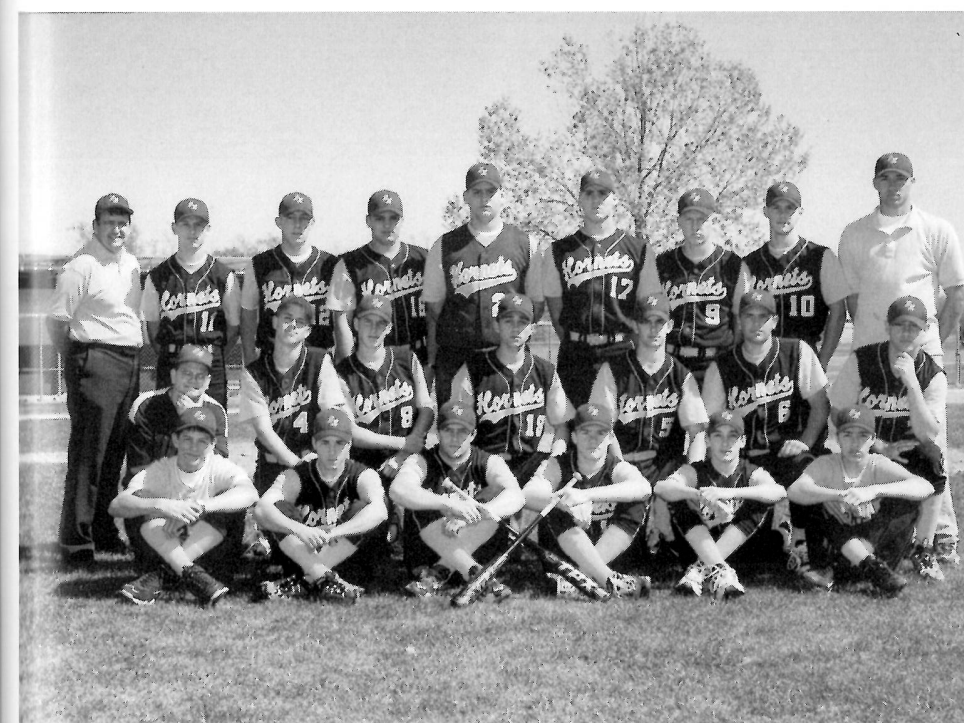
