Principal's Message

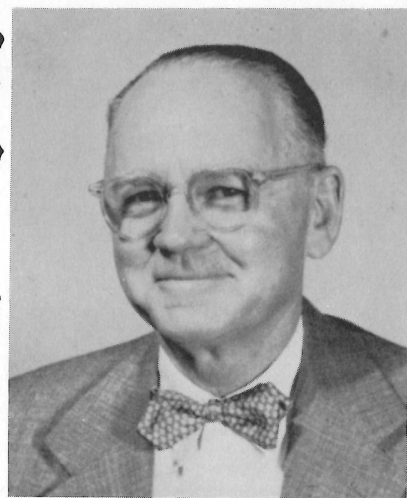
THIS I BELIEVE
