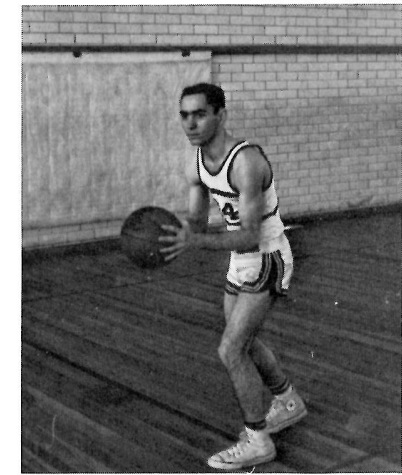
We went to the state tournament in Shreveport. This is the goal of all teams in Louisiana. We were beaten in the Semi-finals by a team that we had beaten previously.

Our team was known throughout the state for its good sportsmanship and outstanding basketball ability.

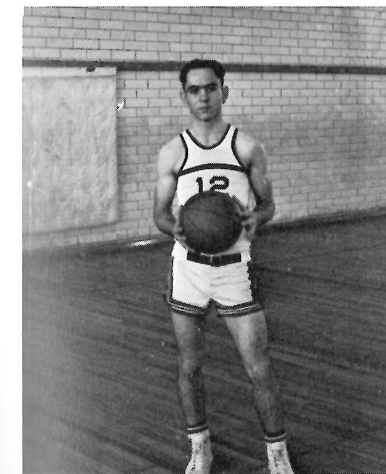
