## SOUTHERN ASSOCIATION EVALUATION



A Committee of Educators representing the Southern Association of Schools and Colleges recently completed a reviewing of the Hackberry High School self-evaluation.

The committee issued a favorable report and recommended that Hackberry High School be accredited by the Southern Association of Schools and Colleges. Commendations and recommendations were made by the committee concerning all aspects of the school. The committee noted a wholesome relationship between the school and community. It was pointed out that facilities are adequate to achieve the desired results. The committee commended the faculty for the high quality of discipline, order, friendliness of students and its ability to provide for students.

It was pointed out that Hackberry High School has formulated a philosophy which seeks to functionally apply to the common and individual needs of the students and the school climate of the community in which they live and that major school objectives consider the individuality of the student, flexibility of curriculum, development of intellectual, physical and moral capabilities, and self discipline in all areas of life.

The visiting committee commended the Cameron Parish School Board and the citizens of Hackberry for constructing a suitable and useable plant for educating students. They also commended the faculty, staff, and student body for their concentrated and combined efforts in keeping the plant and campus in excellent condition. It was pointed out that the staff is utilizing the facilities in an excellent manner to provide an exemplary atmosphere for teaching and training.

The visiting committee found the school staff and administration certified and seemingly well qualified to meet the needs of the students. It was pointed out that the faculty, administration, and community seem to have excellent rapport. It was felt that the school is effectively meeting the needs of most students in the community. The faculty was encouraged to continue professional growth by attending graduate school, workshops, and training programs.

In view of the small size of the school, the faculty and student body were commended for the large number and variety of student activities offered. It was pointed out that the enthusiastic attitude which the students display toward their school provides ample evidence of their satisfaction with the school program. Commendations and recommendations were made in all specific areas of curriculum with the over-all viewpoint being favorable.
