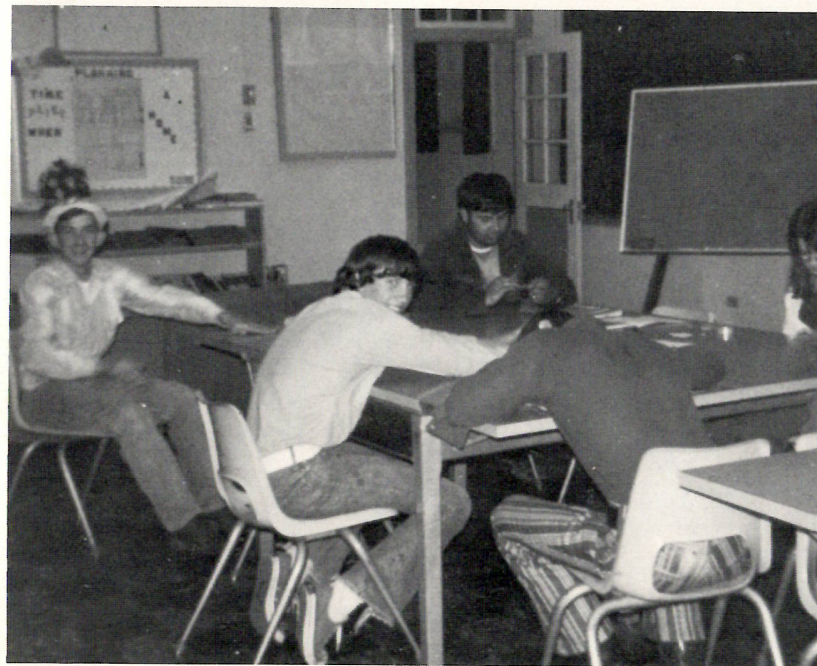
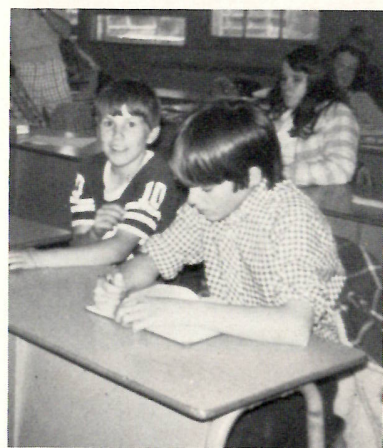
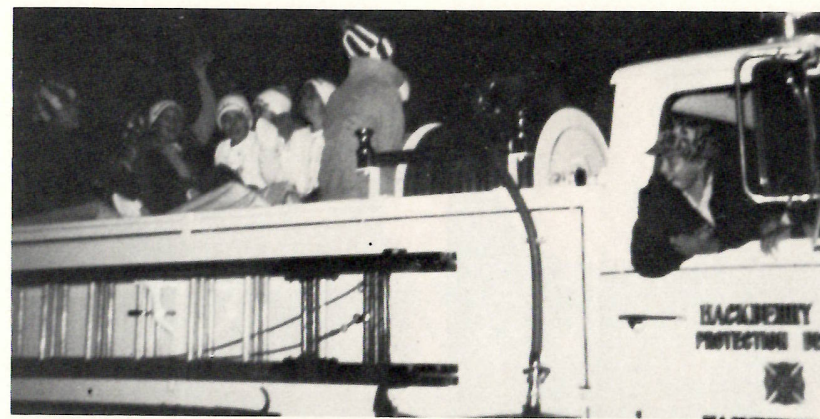
As we relinquish editorship of the HHS Annual, we extend to the future editors our hope that they will consider this post as special an honor as we have.

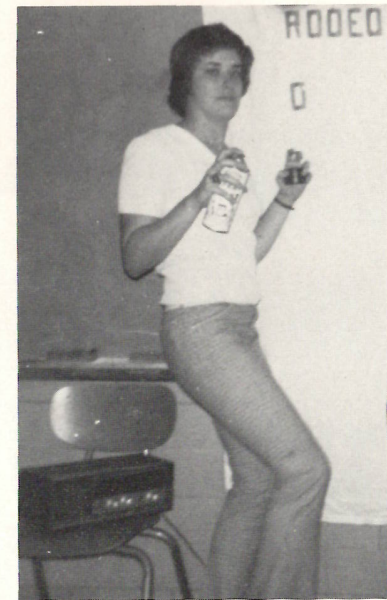
