We see Kevin LaBauve marrying Marla Kay with Missy as the Maid of Honor.

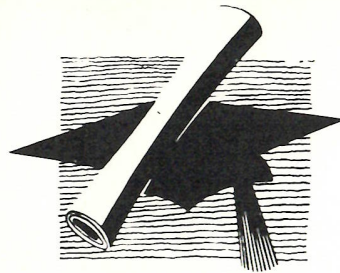
We see Pebbles Hicks finally starring in the Flintstones.

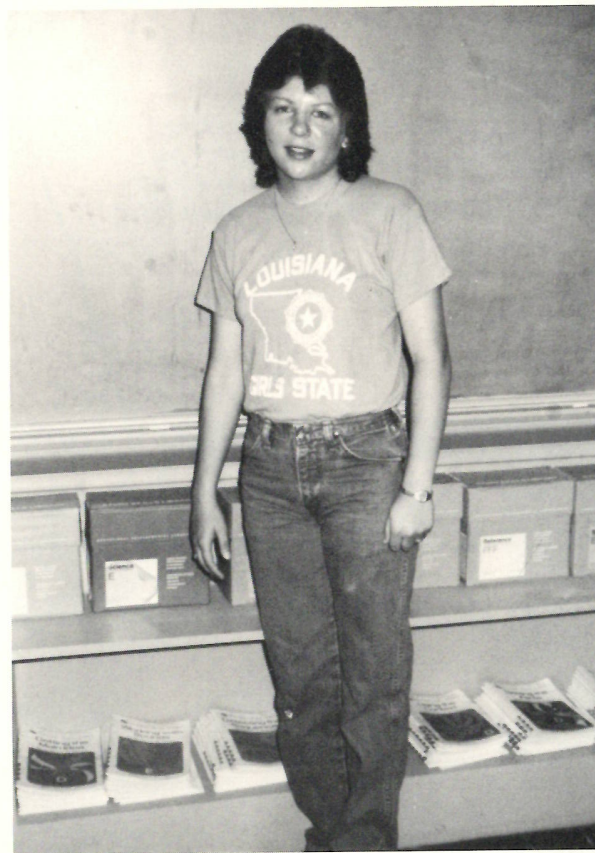
What is Girls' State? Girls' State is an imaginary state which is run like Louisiana and the other states. It has real cities and parishes. Two cities make a parish.

Each city must develop a project for improvement of their own area. The city engineer must draw up actual plans, the same as an architect would. The plan must be reasonable and economical.

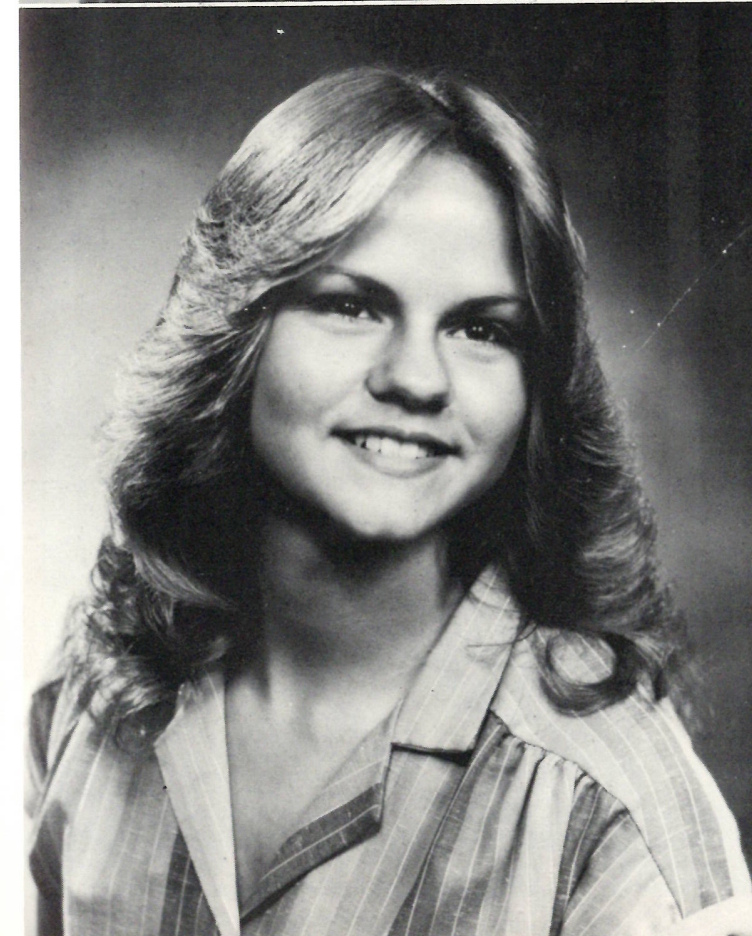
Each person has a part at Girls' State. No one is left out. Anyone who attends Girls' State leaves with some idea of how government really works.

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

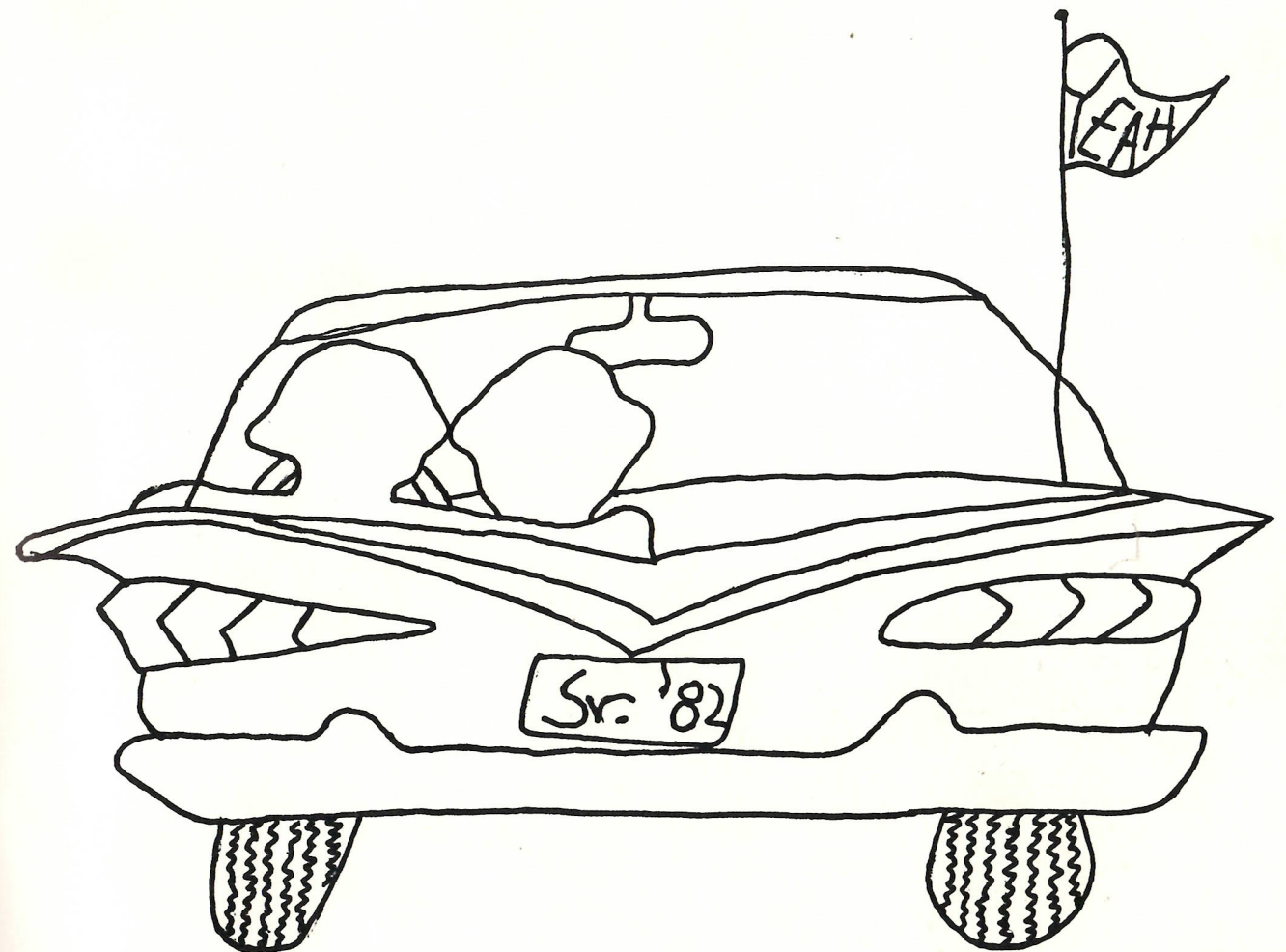
