SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER BETTY SEAY

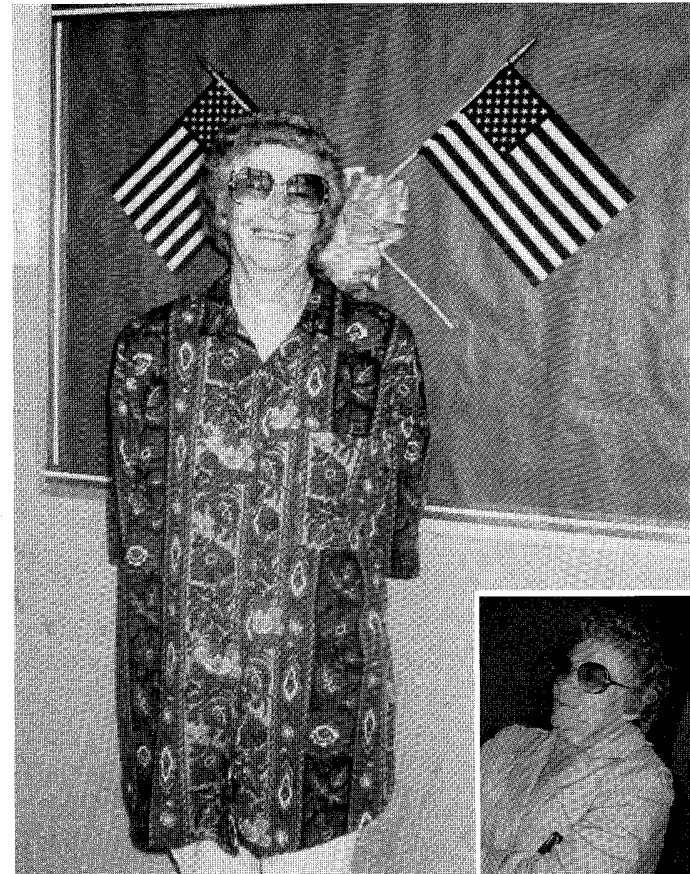
Extensive studies have been made toward implementing programs to establish a more positive attitude in our school.
