Veterans were given a questionnaire about their wartime experiences. These along with some of their keepsakes were on display in the library.



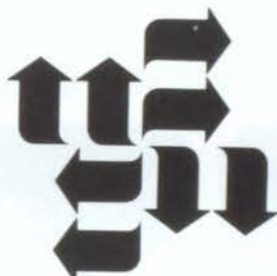
