The school year had started and it was looking to be a great year. Hurricane Katrina hit and our community had become a safe haven for many evacuees. Little did we know that we would soon become victims ourselves. On September 24th, Hurricane Rita hit the southwest corner of our state with a fury. No one ever expected such devastation. One thing was for sure, our lives would be forever changed and it would be a long time before we would see "normal".



Getting Our Act Together

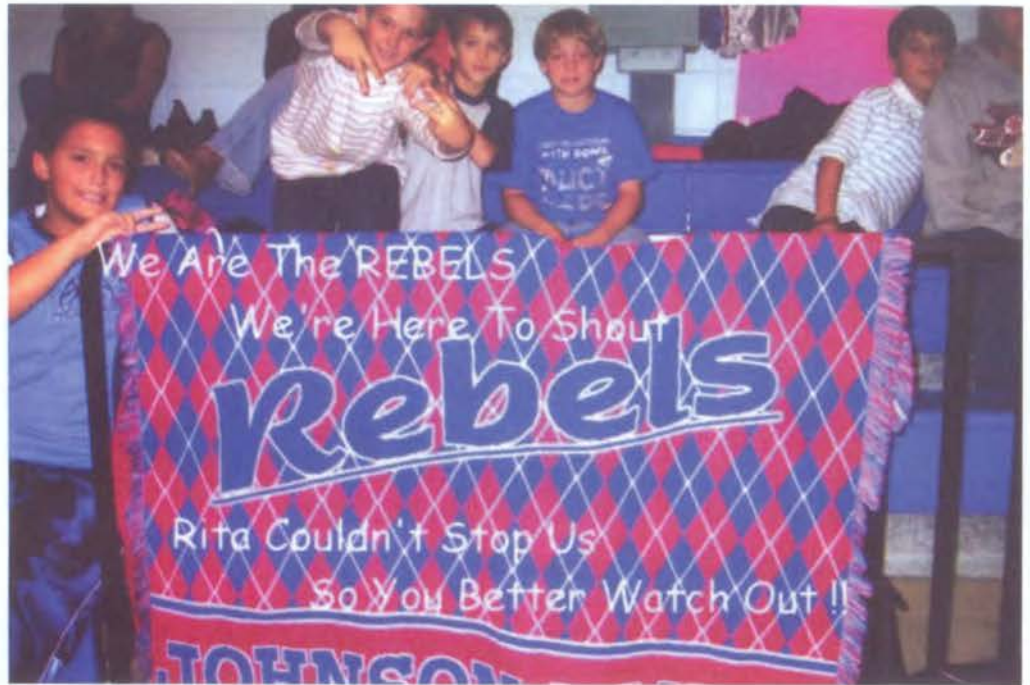

It was decided that Johnson Bayou would share days with Hackberry and Cameron with Grand Lake. A meeting of parents and students was held to see how many students would return. Students would be bussed from Sulphur and Johnson Bayou so as many students could attend as possible. Hackberry welcomed us and we resumed school on November 1st. Students attended 2 1/2 days a week. Although we were still far from home it was good to see everyone and draw strength from each other. It was the first step on the long road home.

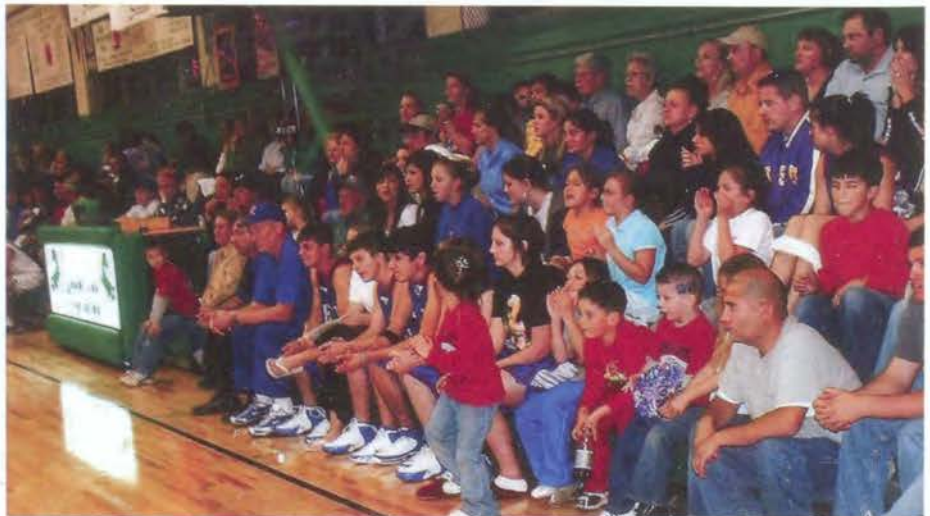


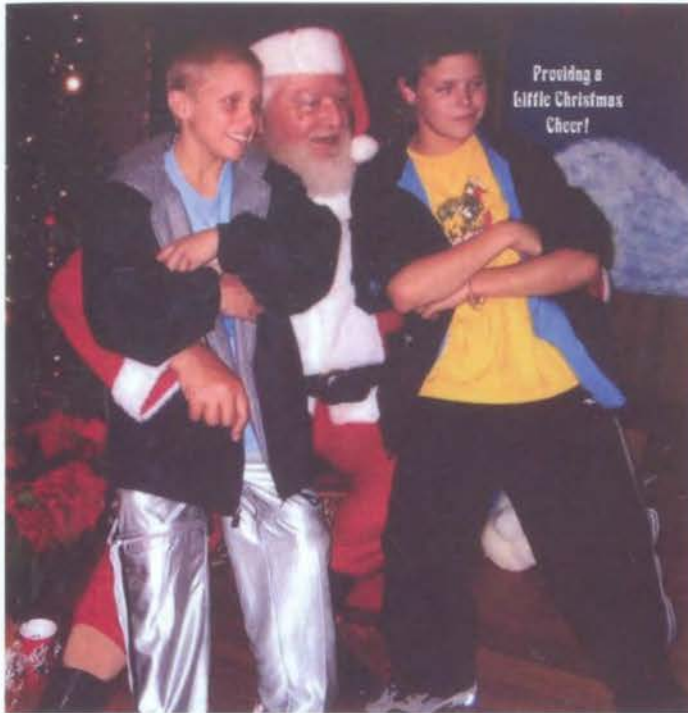
Can't Keep A Good Rebel Down

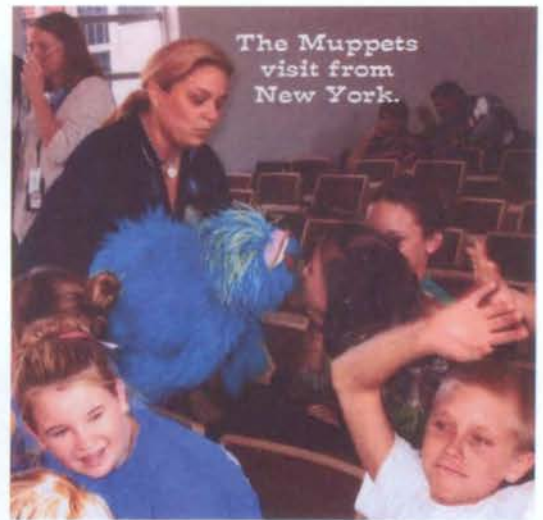

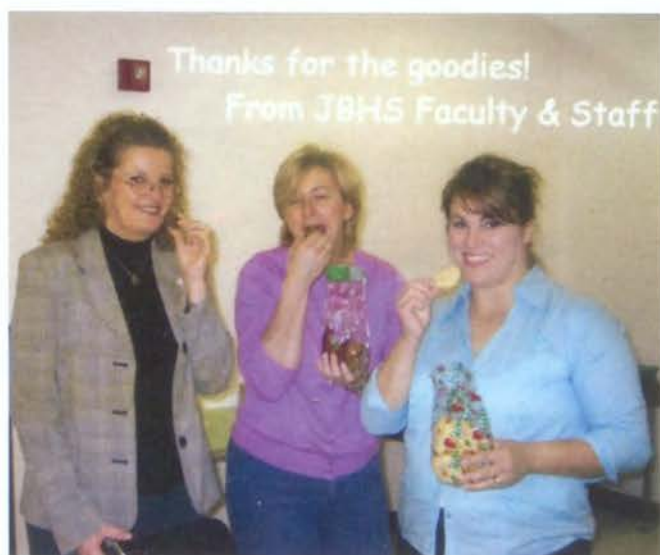
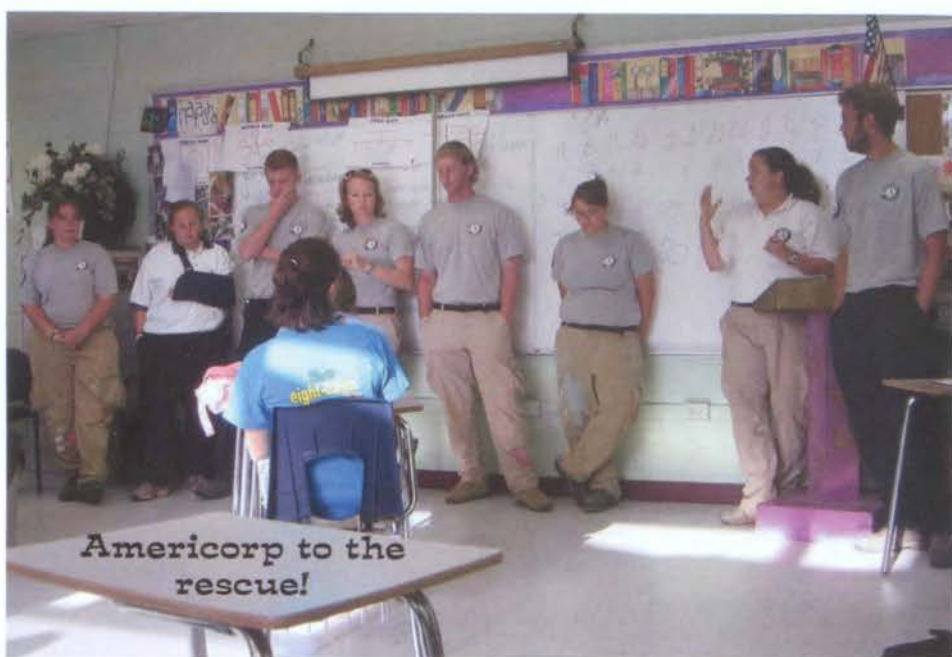

Tragedy has a way of teaching lessons that books can not. Johnson Bayou had always relied on its own for survival. At a time when the community was paralyzed it was others who reached out and taught us the true meaning of compassion. There was a tent load of food from Baton Rouge, chicken from Minden, helping hands from Americorp volunteers and many, many others. A school named "Cameron" sent a quilt, and cookies for the faculty came from New England.



The Methodist Church from Grand Lake provided snacks for coke break. The Ag Dept. was given a kubota from Henderson Implement, Williams donated \$10,000 to the school for new uniforms, an anonymous \$1,000 gift was given to a family of the community, and jackets for all students was donated by Cheniere. The outpouring of donations was a reassurance to all that there were those who cared and would see us through to the end.

From the beginning it was clear that going 2 1/2 days a week was not be the best way to provide a quality education but it was the only option at the time. Getting Johnson Bayou into their own classrooms was the best solution, but just how was the big question. It was Cheniere to the rescue when they stepped in and donated portable classrooms for Johnson Bayou. the buildings would be placed behind Hackberry school.



After the announcement had been made students and parents waited for the arrival. With winter setting in, it was a long wait, but by the end of January the buildings were in place.

Americorp volunteers helped move equipment, books, and desks. The buildings were carpeted and created a cozy, safe environment. Children and faculty alike were drawn one step closer to their journey home.

Cheniere also donated 30 wireless laptop computers so that students could continue computerized learning that is vital to improving LEAP scores.

With graduation drawing near the 2006 graduates were eager to hold their graduation ceremony at the school. With no sign of clean-up in sight, Cheniere offered to provide equipment necessary to hold the ceremony under the pavilion. Williams employees assisted in the set up. On May 20th, the Class of 2006 brought many people home for the first time. It was a magical day that provided a roller coaster of emotions that only solidified what was in everyone's heart,

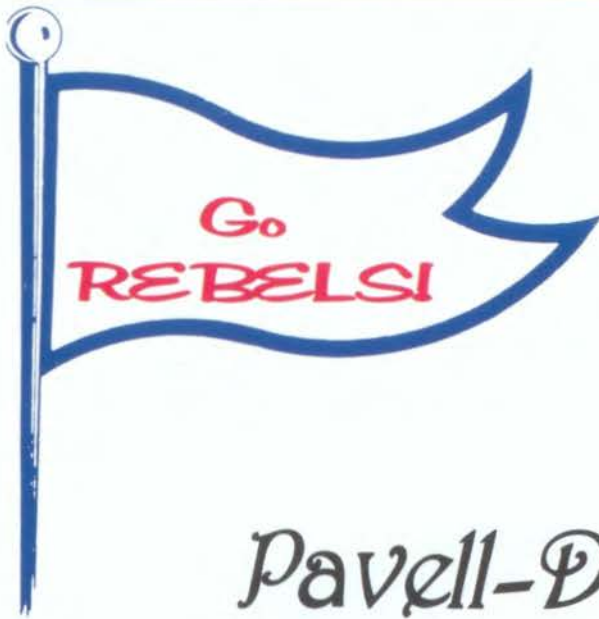

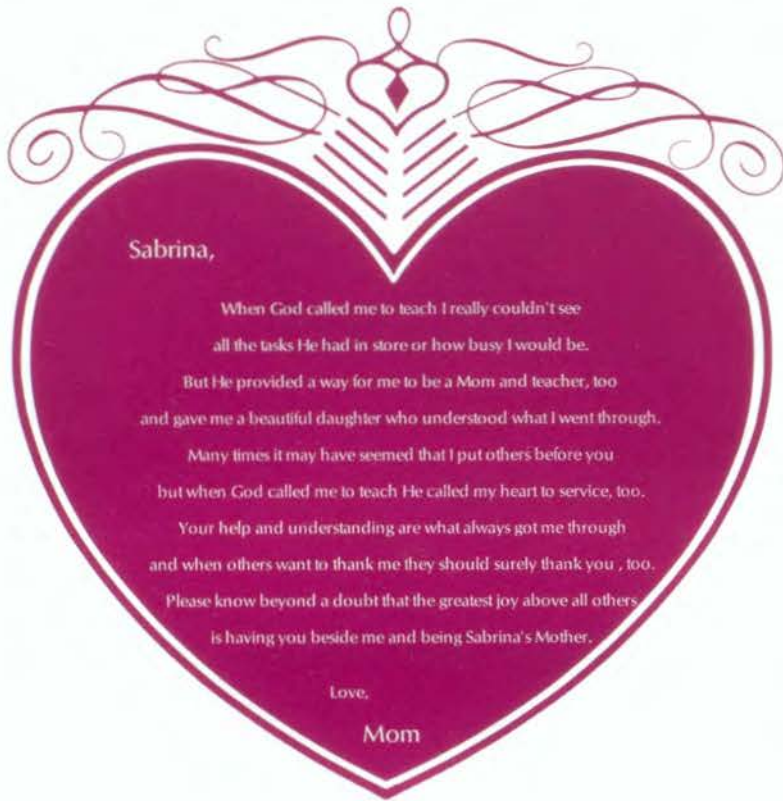
