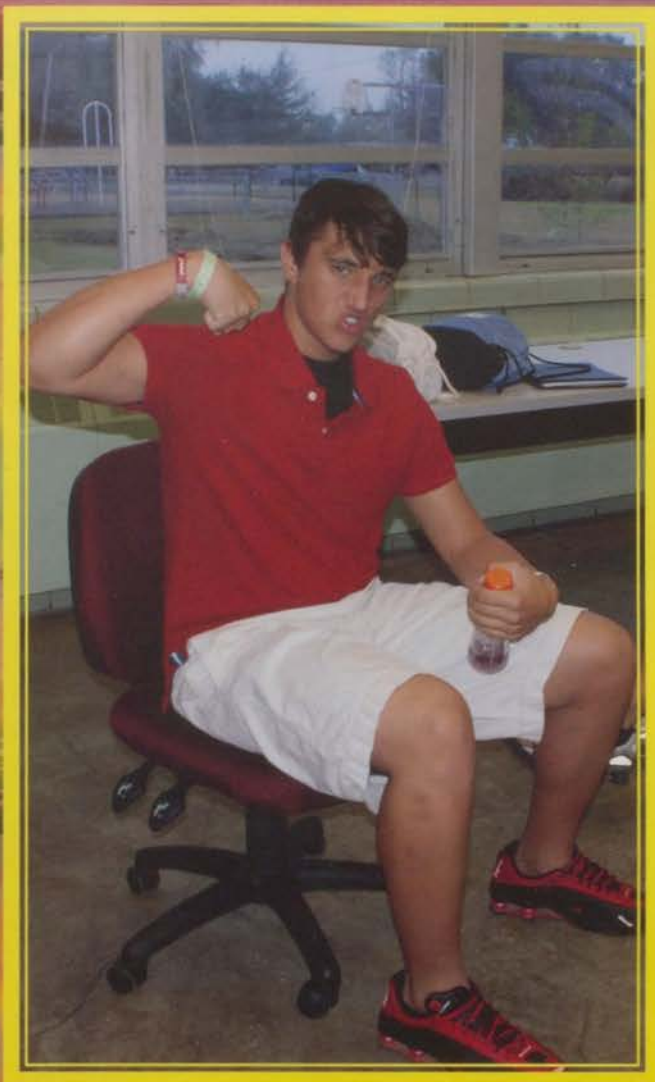




Junior Prophecy
