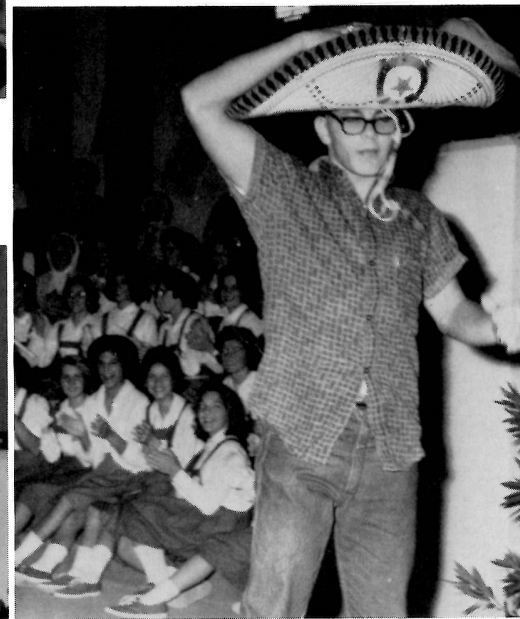

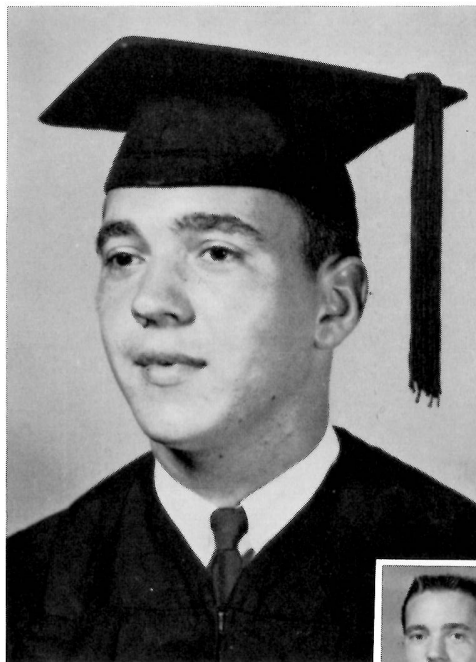


The chief concern of our friends and parents is what will become of the class of the current year. We are happy to report that the senior class of 1965 has encouraging remarks to present in this year of 1965.
