Mrs. Theriot, we wish you many years of continued health and happiness.

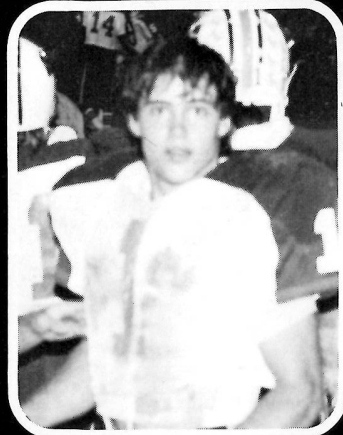
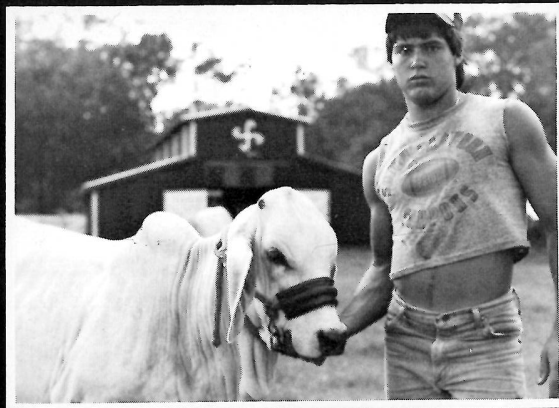
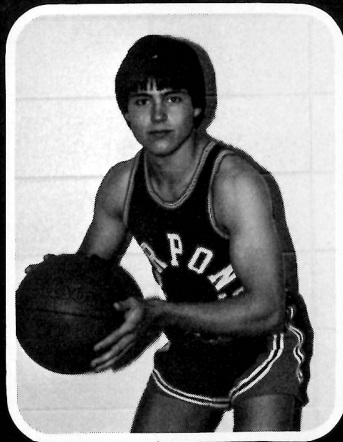

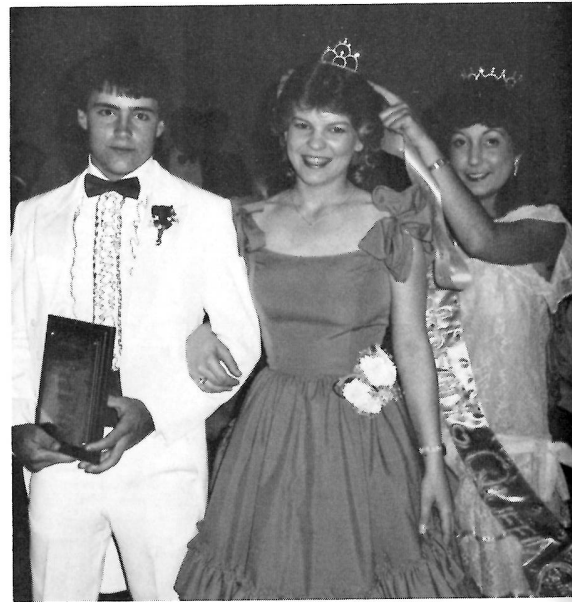


Sweetheart Court & Dance
