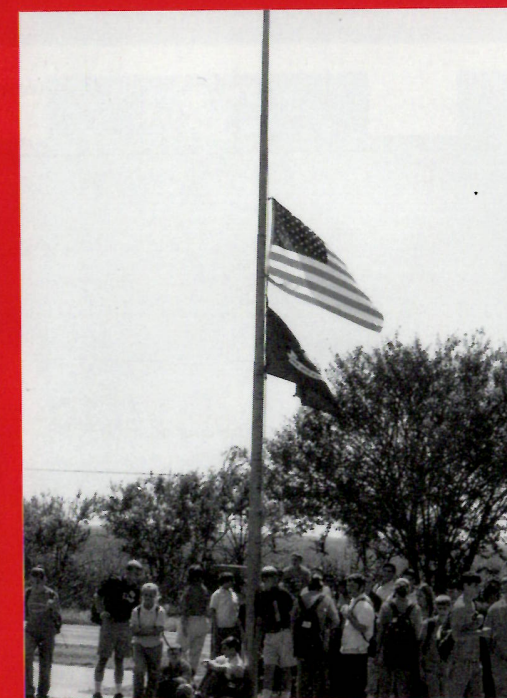

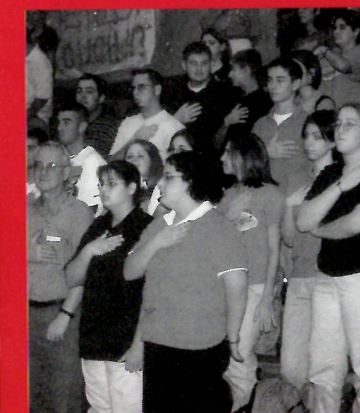

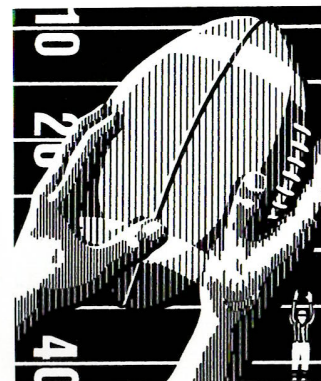

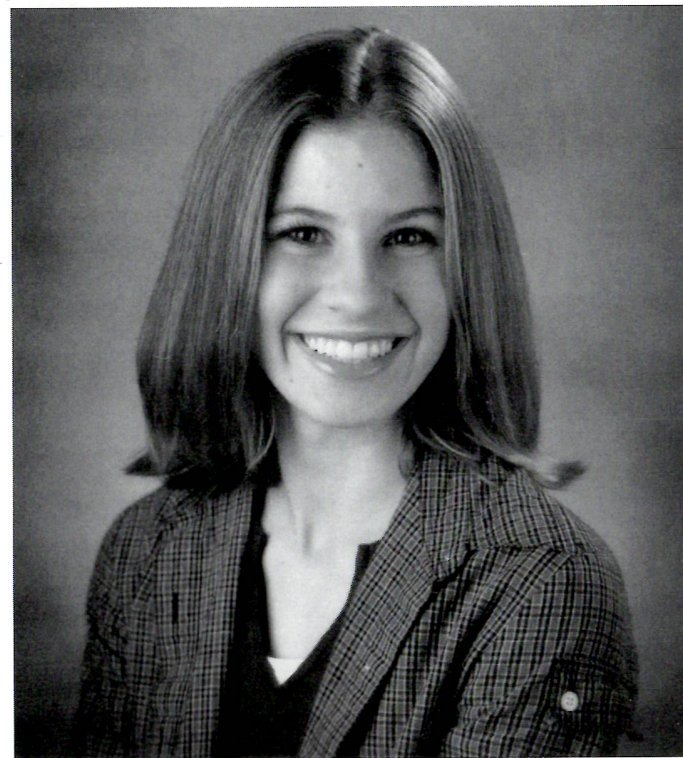


Students of the Year

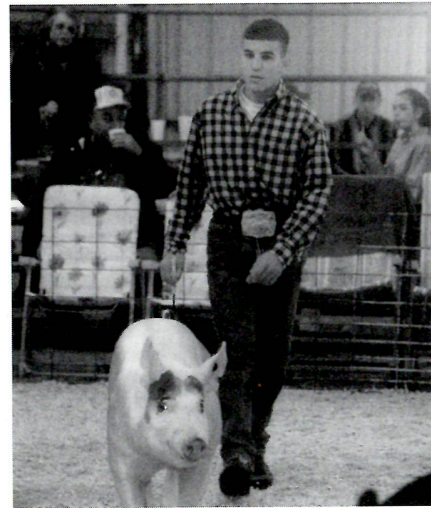

Tarpon Football 2001

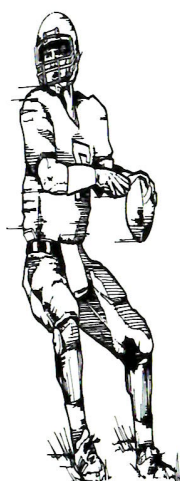

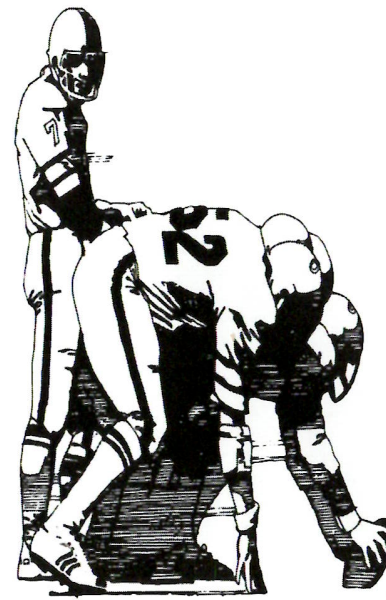

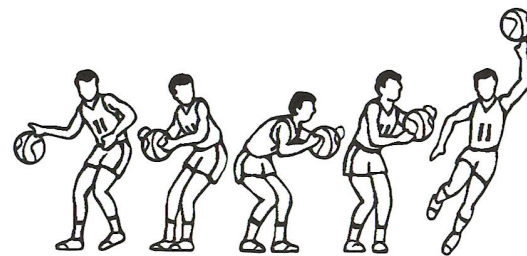

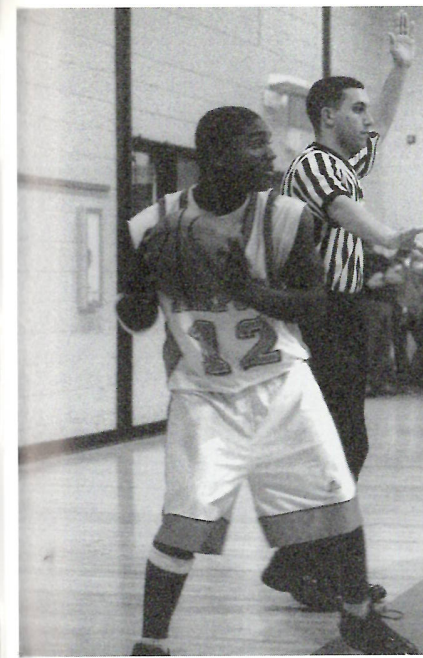

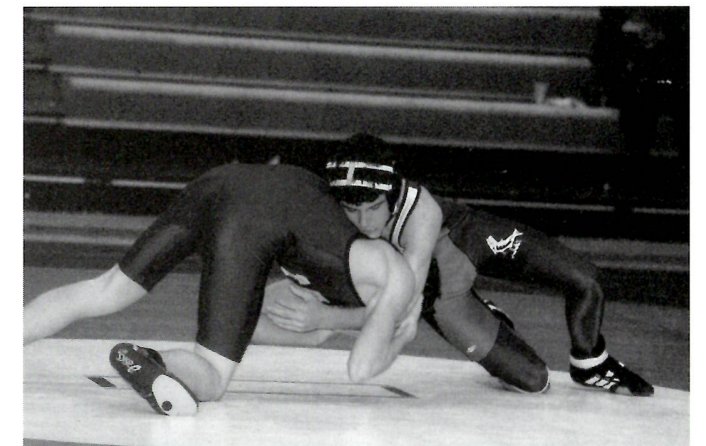
